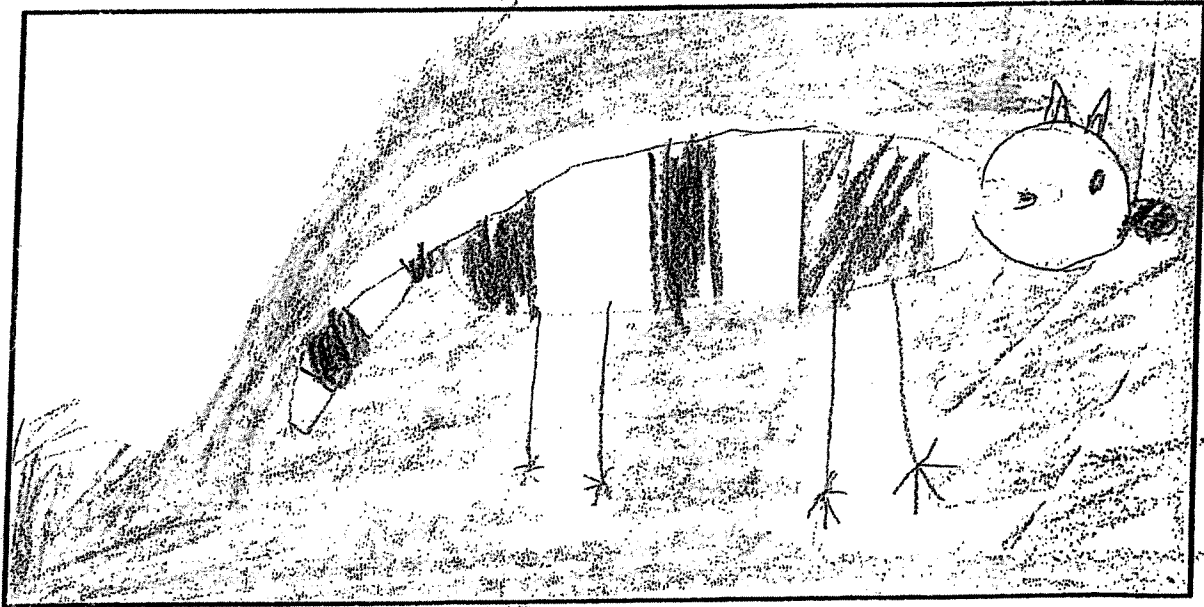

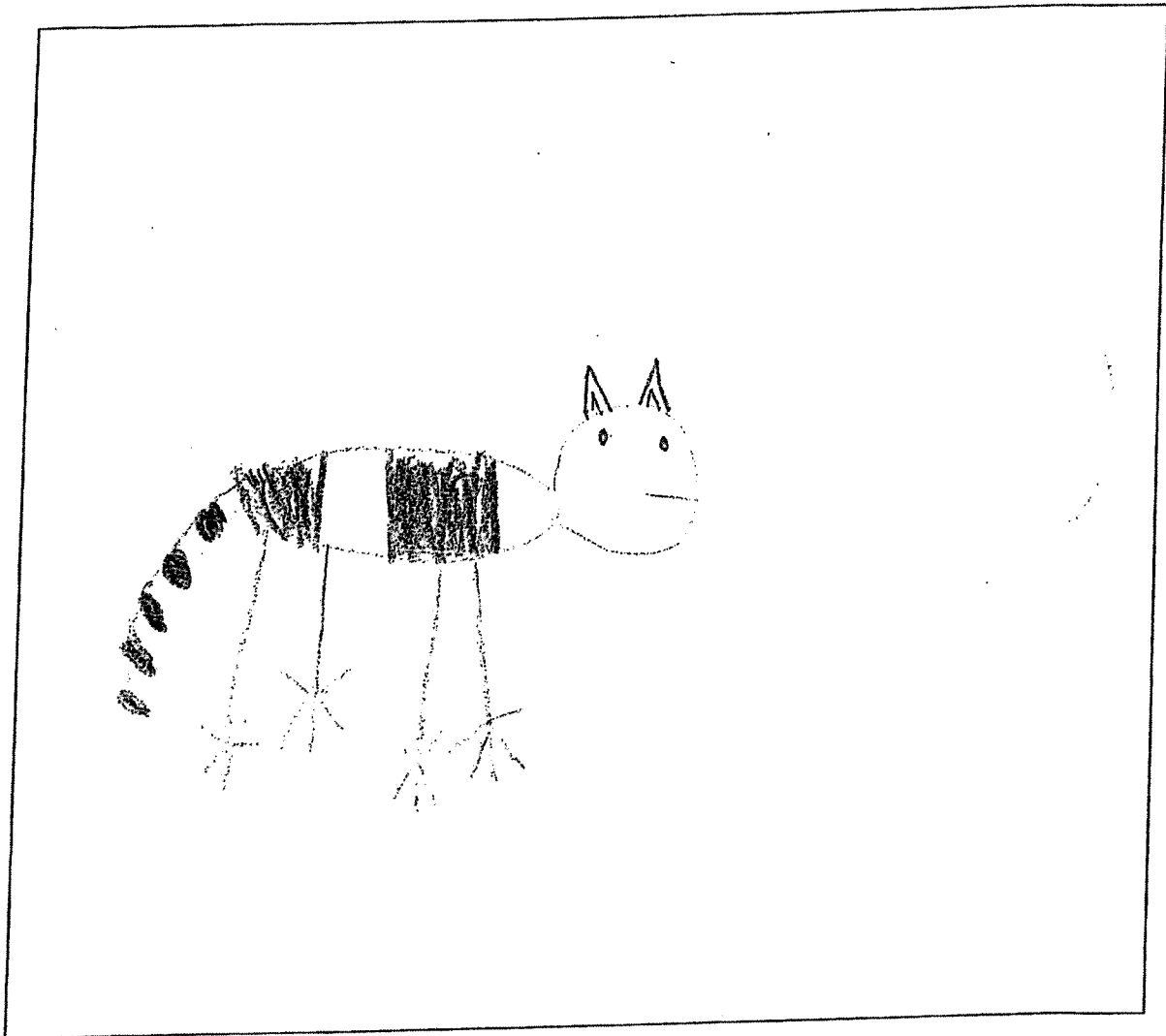

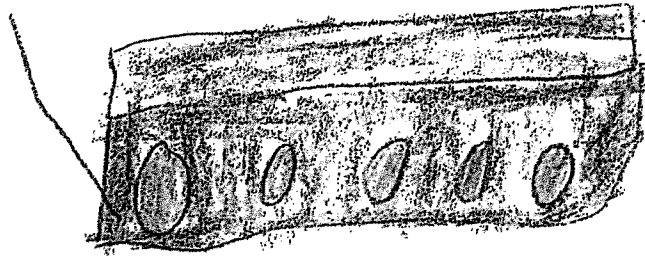
Structural characteristics

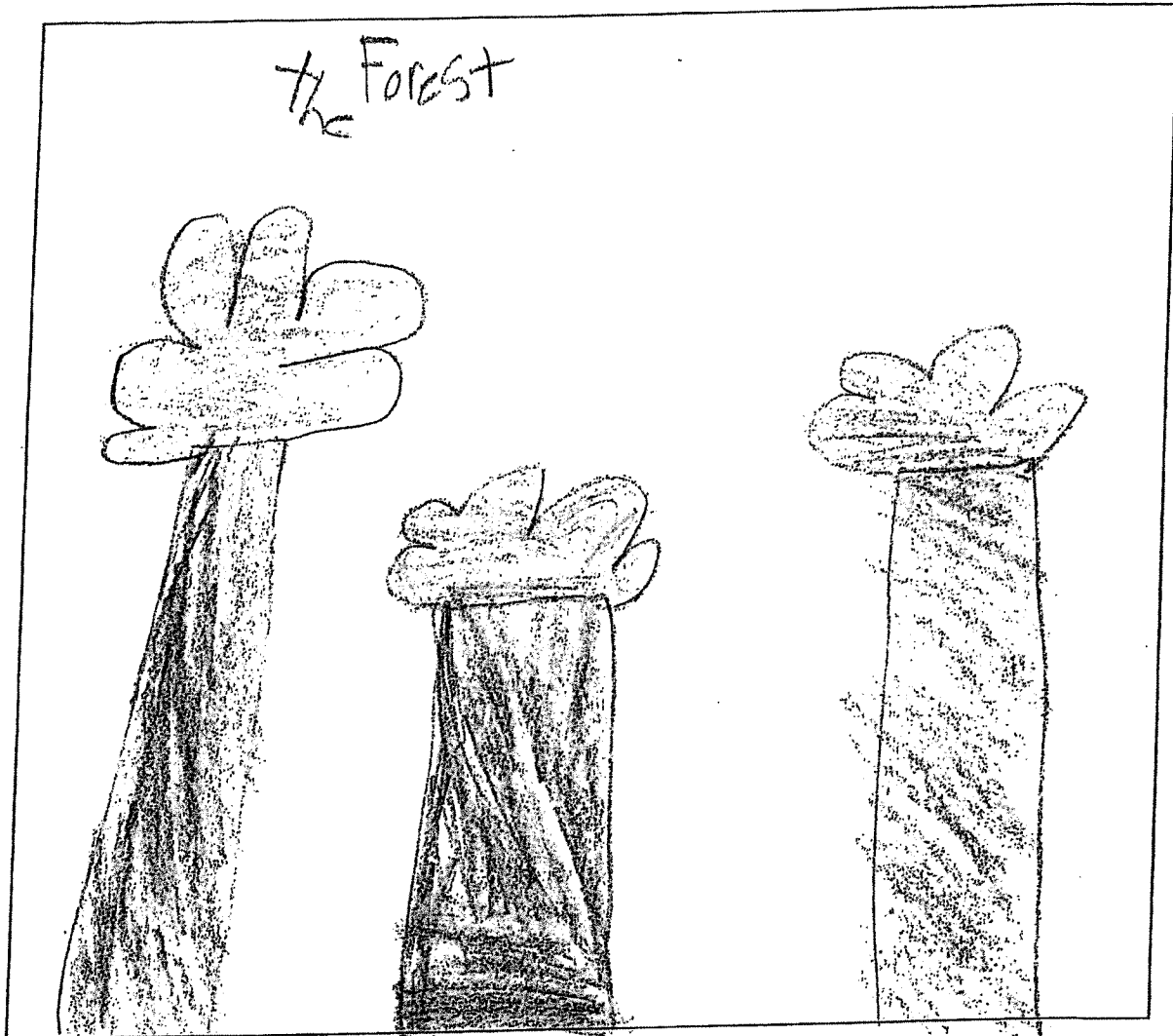
Diet

Special Biscuit



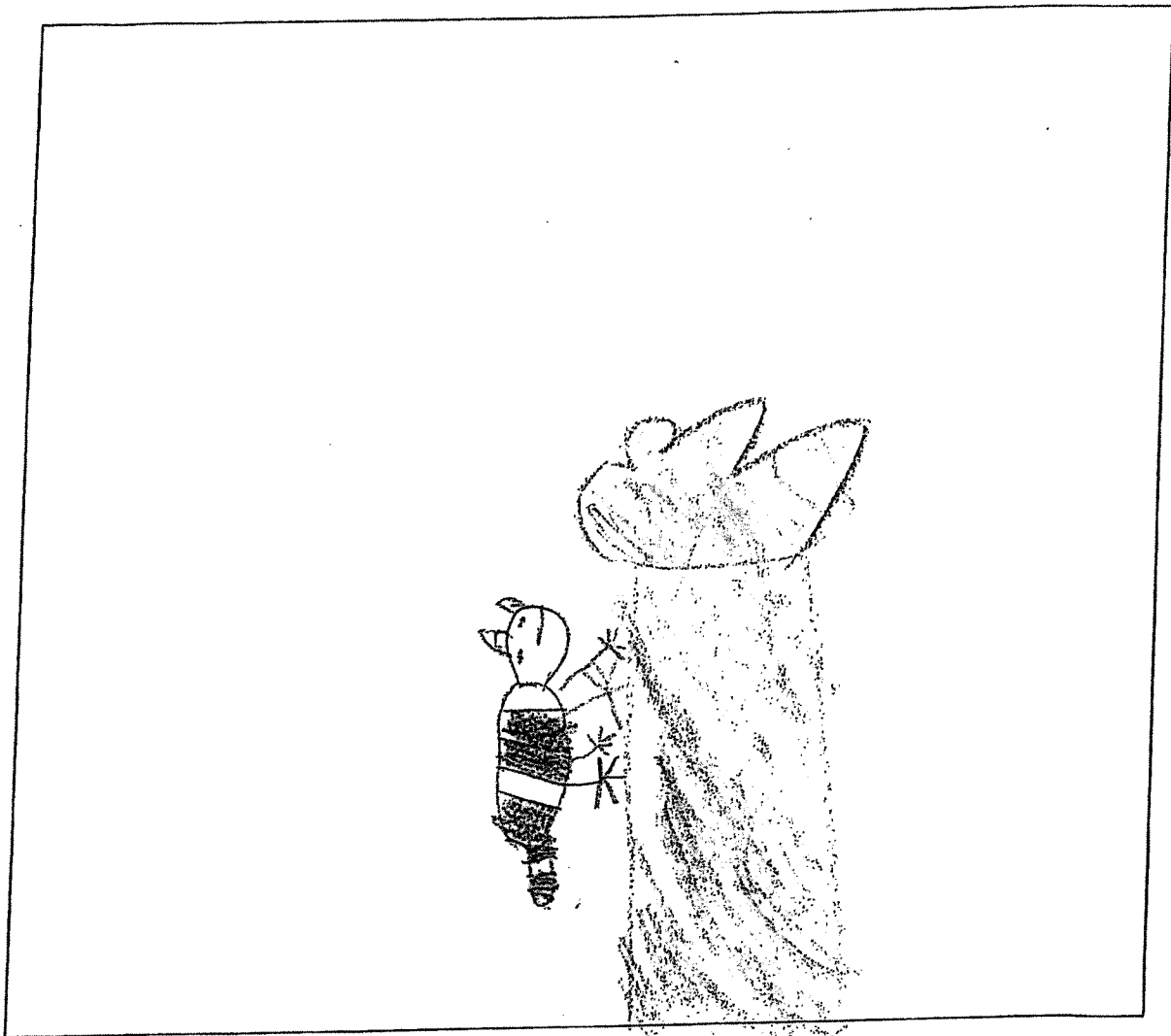
Ring tailed lemur are omnivore because they eat plants and kill trees, insects, birds and lizard. Did you know that Ring tailed lemur are omnivore?
