Because of generous people like you, classrooms across East Lansing were more inspiring this year. Teachers had the opportunity to go beyond the basics and write grant applications for unique opportunities and implement new ideas in their classrooms, while students had the chance to discover just how exciting learning can be!

The middle school cooking club took advantage of a grant from ELEF to purchase supplies benefitting over 75 students who explored the art, science, and practicality of preparing meals together. Through hands-on scratch cooking, students are learning food safety, proper measuring techniques, and engaging with a community beyond their own grade level: important learning for now that will last a lifetime.

We know many teachers face the challenge of buying supplies out of their own pockets to fill their classrooms. On average in the US, teachers spend hundreds of dollars each year to give their students extras that spark imagination and confidence. With your support, we can relieve that burden by supporting our teacher and all students.

As 2025 comes to an end, we'd like to ask you to consider a gift to the East Lansing Educational Foundation to fuel even more learning in 2026:

- \$100 can provide four new math games like Ms. Kain's third grade students used to build skills during math blocks and fifth-grader buddy time.
- \$250 supplies components for three new STEAM stations like in Ms. Spear's music class, where students explore music hands on through diverse activities.
- \$550 could support registration of two middle school teams for Michigan Science Olympiad.
